### Vineyard

The Sauvignon Blanc is from a sandy soil vineyard in Gualtallary (1300 m.a.s.l), the Semillón is from an old vineyard in Tupungato, managed in trellis at 1000 m.a.s.l; and the Tocai Friulano is from Los Chacayes.

### Viticulture

Despite normally ripening at different times, the different altitudes where they grow make them ripe during the same week, and so all varieties are harvested at the same time.

### Winemaking

The varieties are fermented separately with skin contact. Different times of skin contact depending, ranging from one to three months. Then, the wine is racked and the skin pressed. The fermentation finishes slowly without skins. After six months of battonage, the wines are blended. Bottled unfiltered and with very low levels of sulphites.

### Tasting Notes

With a very gentle management of the skin contact, this wine is dry and slightly tannic, deliciously complex and layered with sour grapefruit, mandarin, burnt orange, pears and sour lemon. A note of almond through the long finish.
