Vineyard

Grapes sourced from very small vineyards, which for hundreds of years have been managed by the same families in the Chuchi Pampa settlement. Located at extreme altitudes of more than 2,700 metres in Luracatao, Salta Province.

Viticulture

The Criolla Chica was first brought to Argentina by the Spanish Conquistadors over 300 years ago, making it the original Argentinian grape. Minimal intervention viticulture.

Winemaking

Elaborated with a maceration of three weeks, and fermented in stainless steel tanks with native yeasts. It is made without oak influence, and without any additive outside a minimum of metabisulfite. Matured for ten months in cement tanks.
