### Vineyard

Vineyards located at 2680 m.a.s.l. near the scenic Andean mountain town of Cachi, one of the highest vineyards in the world, and one of the greatest terroirs in Argentina.

### Viticulture

Minimal intervention. Limited production.

### Winemaking

One year in concrete eggs with no oak. Indigenous yeast, and nothing but a bare minimum of metabisulphite added.

### Tasting Notes

'What the French call "garrigue" - the smell of wild herbs - dominates the nose and palate of this intense, unoaked Malbec from stony soils at 2,690 metres in Cachi. Spicy, complex and well balanced with fig and bramble fruit, fine tannins and supporting acidity'
