Vineyard

Agustin Lanus and a small handful of Calchaquí Valley winemakers are currently producing wines from vineyards at the very limits of where grapes can be grown. These vineyards are located in extremely isolated locations, making the time, resources and costs of sustaining the vineyards a challenge for even the most ardent oenologist. Angastaco, Salta: 2,400 masl. - Amaicha del Valle, Tucumán: 2,200 masl. - Hualfin, Catamarca: 2,100 masl.

Viticulture

Manually harvested, transported in boxes of 16 kg at night from the Upper Valle to Cafayate, double selection table.

Winemaking

Spontaneous fermentation with indigenous yeast in concrete tanks, 25 days of maceration, spontaneous malolactic fermentation.

Aged for 15 months in a mix of 50% in neutral barrels, and 50% concrete eggs. Bottled unfiltered and unfiltered.

'Inky, perfumed and intense, with very little wood influence, it's a wine that's fresh and sappy with layers of hibiscus and blackberry pastille'
