Vineyard

Luracatao is the most remote place in the Calchaquí Valley, with very old and heavy soils, this vineyard is within a 300 years old farm located at 2,730 m.a.s.l.

SUNAL SALVAJE Luracatao is an expression of this vineyard in its purest and wildest state.

Viticulture

Minimal intervention. Limited production.

Winemaking

One year in concrete eggs with no oak. Indigenous yeast, and nothing but the bare minimum of metabisulphite.

Tasting Notes

'Dense, perfumed and very much a northern Argentinian style from Agustín Lanús, this varietal Malbec is savoury, floral and focused, with lavender, pine and wild thyme aromas and a core of blackberry, tapenade and black olive flavours' 93 points - [Tim Atkin MW](#)
