Vineyard

Produced from vineyards at 1,700 metres near the town of Cafayate, in the up and coming wine region of Calchaquí Valley.

Viticulture

Minimal intervention.

Winemaking

Maceration in press with dry ice for 4 hours. Long, cool fermentation for 25 days at 14 C°. No malolactic fermentation for either varietal, and aged without oak.

Tasting Notes

Torrontés is famous throughout Argentina for its floral profilet, while Viognier, harvested early, brings aromas of apricot, pear and violets, making this a very complex, fresh and unique wine. Bad Brothers ToVio offers an excellent balance of acidity and freshness with floral overtones typical of high altitude vineyards, while also delivering a wine with a rich, expansive palate filled with flavours of stone fruit and oranges. The colour is an intense yellow with hints of green-gold.
