



## AGUSTÍN LANÚS SALVAJE LURACATAO 2019

**REGION:** Salta, Calchaqui Valleys, Argentina

**APPELLATION:** Luracatao

**VARIETY:** 100% Malbec

### VINEYARD

Luracatao is the most remote place in the Calchaquí Valley, with very old and heavy soils, this vineyard is within a 300 years old farm located at 2,730 m.a.s.l.

SUNAL SALVAJE Luracatao is an expression of this vineyard in its purest and wildest state.

### VITICULTURE

Minimal intervention. Limited production.

### WINEMAKING

One year in concrete eggs with no oak. Indigenous yeast, and nothing but the bare minimum of metabisulphite.

### TASTING NOTES

'Dense, perfumed and very much a northern Argentinian style from Agustín Lanús, this varietal Malbec is savoury, floral and focused, with lavender, pine and wild thyme aromas and a core of blackberry, tapenade and black olive flavours' 93 points - **Tim Atkin MW**
