



## AGUSTÍN LANÚS BAD BROTHERS MATACA BLEND 2017

**REGION:** Salta, Argentina

**APPELLATION:** Calchaquí Valley

**YIELD (HI/Ha):** 60hl/ha

**BLEND:** 60% Malbec, 21% Tannat, 19% Cabernet Sauvignon

### VINEYARD

The vineyard is located at 1,700 masl, in the outskirts of the quiet town of Cafayate. It sits on the floor of a desert valley surrounded by the towering Andes mountains. Cafayate is famous for year-round sunshine, with approximately 320 sunny days each year. Combined with the cool nights typical of high desert terroirs, the vineyards benefit from wide thermal amplitude.

### VITICULTURE

Handpicked manual harvest.

### WINEMAKING

Grapes fully destemmed and fermented in stainless steel tanks with selected yeasts. The must was cold soaked for 7 days at 10°C, and then extracted with pump-overs and delestage (rack and return) techniques, with a total extended maceration of 30 days. 70% aged 15 months in tank with French oak staves, 30% in used French oak barrels, then 10 months of bottle ageing.

### TASTING NOTES

MaTaCa, a blend that brings together the fruitiness and smoothness of Malbec, the volume and structure of Tannat and the elegance of Cabernet Sauvignon.

Full-bodied wine with nice acidity and round tannins.

Deep violet colour, with aromas of red fruits, violets, roses, and fig jam.
