



AGUSTÍN LANÚS SUNAL SALVAJE PUCARÁ MALBEC 2019

REGION: Salta, Calchaqui Valleys, Argentina

APPELLATION: Pucara

VARIETY: 100% Malbec

VINEYARD

Single vineyard located at 2,400 m.a.s.l. in Pucara, Angastaco, Salta Province. The vineyard has sandy-clay soils, permeable and uses drip irrigation. Only 2 hectares.

VITICULTURE

Handpicked manual harvest. Minimal Intervention. Limited production

WINEMAKING

This wine is uninfluenced by wood. It is fermented in concrete tanks with controlled temperature, cold pre-fermentation for 4 days at 10°C. Only indigenous yeasts with a minimum of metabisulfite added and no other additives. Natural malolactic, aged one year in concrete eggs. Unfiltered.

TASTING NOTES

Deep black colour that darkens the glass. On the palate, cranberry and raspberry is prominent, as well as beets and fig jam. The palate is mouth filling with juicy and silky tannins. Pure fruit and expression of terroir.
