



## VIÑA ALTO ROBLE, SANTA ALBA RESERVE PINOT NOIR 2019

**REGION:** Central Valley

**APPELLATION:** Maule Valley

**YIELD (HI/Ha):** 80hl/ha

**VARIETY:** 100% Pinot Noir

**WINEMAKER:** Eloísa Uribe

### VINEYARD

The Yerbas Buenas estate is in an area close to the Andes Mountains with a warm temperate climate. The influence of the mountains is revealed in the lowest temperature average of Chile's Central Valley region. Annual rainfall averages about 800 millimeters (32 inches), almost all in the winter months. Shallow alluvial soils of sandy loam, brownish-gray, rocky; subsoil composed of boulders and rounded rocks in sandy matrix.

### VITICULTURE

Vine management system: Trellis

Hand picking, with double selection in vineyard, in the second half of March.

### WINEMAKING

Maceration: 14-16 days.

Extraction: Traditional pumping-over and punching.

Fermentation: Starts with active dry yeast (Bayanus); temperature 18-20 degrees C.

Aging: Wine conserved over its lees in stainless steel tanks with French oak staves for 6 months.

### TASTING NOTES

Cherries, wild berries and a note of cinnamon smoke all appear on the alluring and inviting nose of this Pinot Noir. The palate is elegant and has just a touch of weight, fine smoky tannins, dark cherries covered in chocolate and vanilla ice cream can all be found in this superbly crafted wine.
