



## BOUCHON GRANITO SEMILLON 2019

**REGION:** Maule Valley, Chile

**APELLATION:** Maule Valley, Chile

### VINEYARD

Granito is a micro-terroir in a granitic soil which is more than 120 million years old. They are old vines with deep roots. It is minerality expressed in the bottle. This Semillon is from Block 1 Batuco's vineyard, Maule's Dry coastal area, 30km from the Pacific Ocean and 183 meters above sea level.

### VITICULTURE

It is a product of old vines planted in the 1940's, which did not receive any irrigation. It is hand harvested at the end of March.

### WINEMAKING

Grapes are pressed in a vertical press, followed by barrel fermentation and then the wine is aged for 12 months in French oak barrels.

### TASTING NOTES

'There are only 4,500 bottles of this stunning wine for the world, alas, so join the queue to get hold of some. Sourced from 80-year-old vines in Pacific-influenced Batuco, this is stony, focused, taut and refreshing, with wax, fresh bread and citrus flavours, some added texture from 100% malolactic, subtle reduction and remarkable palate length. 2022-29' **96 Points** Tim Atkin MW
