VINEYARD

Mingre, dry costal area, 45 kms from the Pacific Ocean and 193 meters above sea level. It sits on the western side of Chile's Coastal Mountains.

Very old soil, granitic sandy loam, formed from granite from the Coastal Mountains, full of quartz and other minerals.

VITICULTURE

Handpicked harvest during second week of March

WINEMAKING

Cold maceration 12 hours at 8°C.

Fermentation 21 days in stainless steel tanks at 14-16°C.

TASTING NOTES

Delicate and elegant salmon colour.

The nose is intense, with a wide range of aromas, from white fruits to cherry aromas, and a floral touch which gives it an elegant and complex character. In the mouth is very fresh, with nerve and elegance.
