



## BOUCHON PAÍS SALVAJE BLANCO 2018

**REGION:** Maule Valley, Chile

**APPELLATION:** Mingre, Maule Valley

**YIELD:** Very low, and unknown due to being wild vines

**VARIETY:** 100% País

**WINEMAKER:** Christian Sepúlveda

### VINEYARD

País Salvaje blanco is a wine born from a second wild discovery within J.Bouchon's País 'jungle' vines. After their first harvest of País Salvaje in 2015, the 2016 harvest began and they realised that certain clusters of these wild vines were much lighter in colour than others. They decided to harvest and vinify these lighter clusters separately.

### VITICULTURE

These wild vines never had human intervention; they grow and climb among the native species that abound in the ravines and hills. Harvesting is done by hand and requires the use of ladders (up to 5 meters long) to reach the grapes. The purest expression of organic and sustainable growth.

### WINEMAKING

It is wild fermented with minimum temperature control. The wine is kept in clay amphorae, which accentuates micro-oxygenation and complexity. Finally, the wine is neither filtrated nor clarified.

### TASTING NOTES

Pale gold, ripe and earthy with a saline, citrus, baked grapefruit and drying skin tannins. Unique and full bodied, good length and crisp acidity.
