Malbec: from Valle de Uco, Tunuyán, Districts of Los Arboles and Vista Flores. 1000 to 1200 masl.

Cabernet Sauvignon: from the Uco Valley, San Carlos, Paraje Altamira. 1100 masl.

Merlot: from Valle de Uco, Tunuyán, Districts of Vista Flores and Los Chacales. 1300 masl.

Petit Verdot: from Valle de Uco, Tunuyán, District of Los Arboles. 1100 masl.

VITICULTURE

Sustainable practices. VPS--DRIP IRRIGATION.

WINEMAKING

Cold maceration at 8°C for 5 days followed by fermentation at 30°C for 28 days, 100% Malolactic, aged for 15 months in first fill French oak barrels, natural clarification.

TASTING NOTES

Intense ruby red colour with violet hints. Its aromas are extremely complex and elegant, with notes of ripe black fruits, sweet spices, tobacco and mocha, mixed with fresh floral notes. Intense and deep to the palate, presenting notes of blackberries with a sweet firm tannic finish.
