APPELLATION: La Consulta, San Carlos, Uco Valley

VINEYARD

It sits in the shadow of the 5,830-meter volcano San José. It is one of the coolest part of the valleys, and gives bright acidity, vibrant fruit, fine, supple tannins and a solid structure that gives the wines very good longevity.

The altitude benefits La Consulta's vineyards by increasing the daily duration and quality of sunlight. It also improves air and water quality.

Due to the proximity of the Tunuyan river the terrain in the area is largely alluvial. The soil features a clay and rock base with a stony, sandy surface. This is ideal for viticulture as it allows for good drainage, and forces the vines to grow deep, strong roots.

Aged for 6 months in American oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES

Ripe red fruits, smoke and chocolate all show on the forward and intense nose. The palate has elegant tannins and subtle acidity that all underpin the brambly fruit, sweet smoke and hint of meatiness.
