



VIÑA REQUINGUA POTRO DE PIEDRA FAMILY RESERVE 2018

REGION: Central Valley, Chile

APPELLATION: Curicó Valley

YIELD (Hl/Ha): 45 hl/ha

BLEND: 85% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Cabernet Franc

WINEMAKER: Benoit Fitte

VINEYARD

Warm temperate climate with a Mediterranean rainfall regime and a wide diurnal range of temperatures. This was a result of the proximity of the Pacific Ocean (80 km) and the Andes Mountains (60 km). Annual precipitation averages about 600 millimeters, or 23.6 inches, mainly in the winter months. Soil: deep, clay loam texture with colluvial granite produced by erosion of the hill.

VITICULTURE

Planted in 1964. Trellis System: Pergola

Density: 1,660 plants/hectare (670 plants/acre)

Hand picked with selection in the vineyard, harvested at the end of April.

WINEMAKING

Warm fermentation and maceration took place over 30 days with regular pigeage and remontage. The wine was then aged in new French oak for 18 months.

TASTING NOTES

An intense and brooding nose: warm liquorice, tobacco smoke and caramelised fruit. The palate is full bodied with firm tannins and a bracing structure. There is plenty of flavour here too; plums, black cherry, crème de cassis and wild strawberries. This is a serious and well-made wine.
