



VIÑA REQUINGUA, TORO DE PIEDRA GRAN RESERVA PETIT VERDOT, CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2017

REGION: Central Valley, Chile

APPELLATION: Curicó Valley

VINEYARD

Warm temperate climate with a Mediterranean rainfall regime and a wide range between daytime and night time temperatures, resulting from the proximity of the Pacific Ocean (80 km) and to Andes Mountains (60 km). Annual precipitation averages about 600 millimeters, or 23.6 inches, concentrated in the winter months. Deep soils with loam clay texture.

VITICULTURE

Year of Plantation: 2000

Trellis System: Vertical Shoot Positioning

Density: 5,000 plants/hectare

Soil: Clay loam texture, with some layers of colluvial granite that outcropped due to the erosion of the hill.

WINEMAKING

Following a 4 day cold soak the wine is macerated for 25 days.

Fermentation is at warm temperatures with daily remontage. The wine is aged for 12 months in both French and American oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES

Showing a deep garnet colour and intense notes of spices, black fruit, berries, minty chocolate and a smooth touch of vanilla. In the mouth it's lush and silky, with a spicy character and a juicy palate that leaves a long finish.
